Visitors to Verulam House

We are now asking family members, friends and any visitors to restrict their visits to 1 family member per Resident until further notice.

We are expecting a further Government Announcement later in the week which could result in ALL visits being put on hold.

We are continuing to take preventative infection control measures and have already cancelled all Activity outings to public places. We have cancelled all non-urgent hospital appointments, these will be rescheduled at a later date.

We have given a lot of thought in making this decision, but our priority is to keep our vulnerable residents as safe as possible. We feel that by taking these measures it will prevent us from having to stop all visiting.

We have not taken this decision lightly, and appreciate that this may cause some disappointment, but feel that this is a necessary step to take.

Please ensure that you carry out ALL the preventative measures we are asking visitors to undertake and DO NOT visit the home AT ALL if you are feeling unwell.
