Thank you for your patience.

We have now had an updated review by HCC regarding opening the home to visitors following the outbreak.

At last we are able to open to visitors, the following procedures must be adhered to:-

1. You still need to make an appointment.
2. ALL appointments MUST be booked in advance of the day
3. You still need to do a LFT on the day of the visit.
4. PCR tests are no longer required
5. Please follow the same PPE and signing in procedures.
6. Visits are still to take place in the resident's room and not in communal areas.
7. No more than 2 visitors at one time.
8. Children are allowed to visit, however they will be included as part of the 2 visitors permitted.
9. You need to let us know if you are taking the resident out when booking your appointment
10. Family Dogs are allowed – MUST be always kept under control and on a lead

Residents will be allowed out to be taken for a walk in the fresh air, they are also allowed to go out to family homes as long as family and resident have a negative LFT and the visit is risk assessed.

Window Visits and Face Time will carry on as and when needed.
